Resin Bonded Driveway - Private Residence



The Project

A newly renovated country house in Derbyshire needed a durable and aesthetically pleasing driveway.

The customer's requirements meant that it needed to compliment the house and have a textured finish to accommodate a collection of supercars whilst providing a hard wearing and low maintenance surface that was also suitable for equestrian uses.

The Solution

A Resin Bonded Surface System was chosen to overlay the existing tarmac driveway using an odourless Polyurethane Resin dressed with a 1-3mm Golden Gravel. The Resin Bonded system eliminated the requirements to excavate the existing surface saving both money and time therefore minimising disruption to the client.



Resin Bonded Surfacing is hand-applied by specialist trained installers allowing the product to be applied to awkward areas such as steps and doorways. The quick drying surface can be trafficked in as little as 4 hours.

The Resin Bonded Surfacing System is a 'coat & scatter system' providing a natural texture alongside the appearance of loose gravel.
